This body shall play a pivotal role in policy making and formulate overarching principles and strategies for the activities of the Mission. This body would also suggest new proposals for impacting the quality of teaching and teacher professional development. The Executive Committee shall set up Committee of Experts for various dimensions of the Mission. Specifically, the Executive Committee will be responsible for:

- i) Providing directions for programme formulation and implementation framework for the Mission.
- ii) Periodic review of outcomes and general monitoring of the Mission as a whole.
- iii) Coordination between various Central Ministries and between Centre, States and NGOs, etc.

- v) Decisions regarding delegation of powers (financial or otherwise) to various committees/ authorities/functionaries involved in the Mission or its projects
