ANNOUNCEMENT FOR FOUR (4) PROFESSIONAL INTERNS

The Colombo Plan Staff College for Technician Education (CPSC) opens its doors to young professionals, male or female, who wish to join the CPSC Professional Internship Program for International Experience (PIPIE) for a period of six (6) months or one (1) year starting <u>July 2014</u>

CPSC is an inter-governmental human resources development organization mandated to assist in the improvement of technical and vocational education and training (TVET) systems of its member countries in Asia and the Pacific region through training, research, consultancy and information service. The active member countries of CPSC are: Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Fiji, India, Republic of Korea, Malaysia, Maldives, Mongolia, Union of Myanmar, Nepal, Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, the Philippines, Singapore, Sri Lanka and Thailand.

The concept of PIPIE was formulated and developed in 2004 mainly to: appreciate and develop awareness on CPSC's multi-cultural environment as an inter-governmental international organization; provide opportunity for young professionals to apply and relate principles, concepts and methods learned in their respective areas of studies; provide platform for acquiring practical work experience related to their academic background or future work in the field/s related to CPSC thrust areas; and increase the understanding of interns on relevant and emerging issues in TVET in their country and/or at Asia Pacific regional level through programs, knowledge sharing and research-based project/s.

A PIPIE applicant must be a citizen of any of the CPSC member countries, at least a Bachelor's degree holder and a graduate from a reputable university, preferably with specialization on any of the following fields: technical and vocational education and training (TVET), information communication technology (ICT) or related fields, management, technology education, social science or allied areas, or with Diploma in Engineering/Technology with at least 3 years or equivalent of professional experience in industry and/or TVET institution.

He/she must be between 30 to 40 years old, proficient in the English language (basic speaking and writing skills), computer literate, open to learning and with the ability to work in a multi-cultural environment.

A monthly allowance of US\$250, meals, accommodation in the CPSC hostel and other services (subject to availability of facilities) will be provided by CPSC. Cost of travel-related expenses, such as return airfare, visa application fee (9E Multiple entry), passport, travel insurance and medical certificate/insurance will have to be borne by the interns. (PIPIE Policy is attached for more detailed information).

I. Application and Submission Guidelines

- 1. Interested applicants must complete the APPLICATION FORM which may be downloaded from http://www.cpsctech.org/careers/job-vacancies
 - 1.1 HRM Form A06 (Application Form for PIPIE Intern)
- 2. Submission of application must follow a prescribed process and applicants must be guided by the information below:
 - 2.1 Applicant should complete the prescribed application form ensuring that all information are provided as sought in the form.
 - 2.2 Applicants are requested to send the prescribed *Application Form* to CPSC with the following document requirements:
 - a. Covering letter expressing intent to apply;
 - b. Certificates/Diploma of Bachelor, Master degree from university or college (including certification for eligible graduating applicants)
 - c. Recommendation letter by the (1) Supervising Professor/Immediate Supervisor; and Eminent Expert.
 - d. Copy of Professional Licenses, Certificates of Skills/Relevant Training (if any)
 - e. Ensure that the certified true copies of the above documents be sent as an attachment by email
 - f. Medical certification indicating fitness for overseas assignment.
