**MONTHLY SUMMARY FOR THE CABINET FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE 2022:**

**Important Policy Decisions Taken and Major Achievements During June, 2022**

1. A detailed deliberation on Implementation of National Education Policy, 2020 was held in the National Conference of Chief Secretaries that was held from 15<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 at Dharamshala, Himachal Pradesh,
2. Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav - Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Student exchange programme: The Ministry has launched a country-wide student exchange programme between Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat paired states, as a part of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. Around 50 students from each state/ UT( 25 from schools and 25 from higher education institutions) are visiting their paired states and UTs on a five day tour. The program is aimed at fostering an understanding of diverse socio-economic and living experiences and building empathy. Four such groups have started their visits to the paired states, in June, 2022.
4. Second Asia-Pacific Regional Education Minister's Conference: Hon'ble MoS for Education and External Affairs Dr. Rajkumar Ranjan Singh participated in the 2nd Asia-Pacific Regional Education Minister's Conference on SDG4-Education 2030 (APREMC II) held from 5 – 7 June 2022 in Bangkok, Thailand through pre-recorded statement.
5. Virtual Session with Australian Universities: A Virtual Session with Australian Universities was hosted by the Ministry of Education in collaboration with the High Commission of India at Canberra on 20th and 21st June, 2022. The session included discussions regarding Regulations on foreign collaborations through twinning, dual, joint degree programs, Foreign Campuses in GIFT City, and Opportunities in Skill Development collaboration
