KVS National Social Science Exhibition—cum-National Integration Camp is organized at School, Cluster, and Regional & National level every year. All the 25 regions are allotted one State different from their own State and one Country. The students prepare projects/exhibits on the culture, customs, dress, crops, economy, climate etc of the State and of the Country allotted to them. The States and Countries are rotated each year.
