Minutes of Second meeting of Consultancy Evaluation Committee (CEC) for selection of consultant for review/appraisal of Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA Scheme)-

The second meeting of the CEC chaired by Joint Secretary (SE.1) was held on 13.4.2017 at 4.00 pm to open the applications in response to the Expression of Interest (EoI) published by MHRD on 31.3.2017 and to evaluate the applications received on basis of qualification criteria mentioned in the EoI advertised by this Ministry.

2. To select eligible organisations for issue of Request for Proposal (RFP), the Ministry has published a Expression of Interest (EoI) on 31.3.2017. Due date for the receipt of the applications was 13.4.2017 upto 1500 hours.

3. The committee was informed that 13 applications were received in response to the EoI. Out of the aforesaid 13 applications, the committee was informed that 3 applications namely M/s Datamation Consultants Pvt. Ltd, M/s Sutra Consulting and M/s Gaheli Centre for Research & Development Pvt. Ltd. were received after 1500 hours and these were summarily rejected. The rejected applications may be returned back to the applicants unopened.

4. Applications were opened in the presence of one representative each of M/s Gaheli Centre for Research & Development Pvt Ltd and M/s Tata Institute of Social Science. (Attendance sheet is at **Annexure-I**).

5. Thereafter the opened proposals were checked and it was found that:

- I. Each application was accompanied by Demand Draft amounting to Rs. 5000.00 towards prescribe processing fees of EoI.
- II. Each application received was in duplicate and a soft copy has been provided with each proposal.

6. The applications were thereafter evaluated as per the pre qualification criteria specified under Clause 10 of the EOI document. The details of the Evaluation of 10 applications are placed at **Annexure-II**.

7. Out of 10 applications evaluated, 8 were found eligible. The list of eligible organisations shortlisted for issue of RFP document is given below:
