DURATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

The duration of this scholarship is no less than eight (8) months and is only offered for a

The University, which will hold this course, will be decided by the I.K.Y after the selection process.

START DATE

The courses will start on October 2017 and will end on May 2018.

COURSE OVERVIEW

a. Greek Language

- b. Tuition fees and other relevant costs.
- c. Free emergency medical treatment under the Greek National Health Service (only in public hospitals). European citizens should have the European Insurance Illness Card from their insurance agency of their country.
- d. A monthly allowance of 150, 00€ (net amount) for personal expenses.
- e. 200, 00€ for Initial expenses.
