

## **UKIERI Third Call for Applications**

The third call for UKIERI is now published on [www.ukieri.org](http://www.ukieri.org). The partnerships in key priority areas will build sustainable linkages and provide opportunities to teachers, faculty, academicians and researchers from universities, colleges, further education institutions to build professional capacity. Partnerships with state governments, public institutions and businesses are being strongly encouraged. Please refer to the UKIERI website for all details regarding the eligibility and priority areas.

**Brief Description of the activities is detailed below:**

### **1. UKIERI Further Education Leadership Development Programme**

Terms of Reference has been published to invite applications from UK institutions interested in developing and managing Leadership Programme for Further Education Institutions in India. The aim is to devise and deliver a training programme to train Indian Technical and Vocational College Principals/ /Institutional Heads/CEOs of start up companies and develop academic and organizational leadership and management through a series of workshops, seminars and online exchanges on leadership and management.

### **2. DST UKIERI Thematic Partnerships**

Application form has been published to support research and innovation partnerships across 6 specific subject areas. The areas include: Sustainable energy supply, Food production and security, Water supply and security, Health and Disease, Innovation including social impact and intellectual property and Research & Science Policy.

### **3. UGC UKIERI Thematic Partnerships**

Application form has been published to support research, faculty exchange and innovation across all subject areas. The call is open for all public funded HE institutions in India and the UK.

### **4. UKIERI Sector Skills Collaboration**

Application form has been published to support partnerships with a particular focus on strengthening Sector Skills bodies and their engagement with industry/business and establishing key occupational standards and qualifications.

## **5. UKIERI Institutional Capacity Building Partnerships**

Application form has been published to support partnerships with vocational education institutions and community colleges through training and development of teaching/training staff.

## **6. UKIERI Study India Programme**

Terms of Reference has been published to invite applications from UK and Indian institutions interested in developing and managing Study India Programme for 200 UK students to visit India for a cultural and educational experience.
