**MONTHLY SUMMARY FOR THE CABINET FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL 2022:**

**Important Policy Decisions Taken and Major Achievements During April, 2022**

1. An MoU was signed between India and Norway on cooperation in the field of Higher Education.
2. Establishment of India-US Working Group on Education and Skill Development was announced in India-US 2+2 Ministerial Dialogue.
3. Meeting on establishment of Digital University was held with Stakeholders.
4. A series of meetings were held for integration of Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) and Samarth to enable multiple entry multiple exit scheme for students to complete degrees as per their time preferences.
5. The All India Survey on Higher Education(AISHE) 2020-21 to collect information from the all registered Higher Educational Institutions was completed with a huge response rate from the Institutions (96% Universities, above 90% College and Standalone).
6. Based upon the reference received from UGC regarding draft UGC (Academic Collaboration between Indian and Foreign Higher Educational Institutions to offer Twinning, Joint Degree and Dual Degree Programmes), Regulations, opinion of the Ld. SG of India was sought and communicated to UGC.
