



2	Summer Fiesta 2024	Secretary, Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education, on 29 th May 2024 inaugurated the month-long "Summer Fiesta 2024" at the National Bal Bhavan, New Delhi. Summer Fiesta is a month-long camp comprising over 30 types of different activities for children aged between 5 to 16 years.
