



1	G20 Education Ministers' Meet	<p>Hon. Prime Minister addressed the G20 Education Ministers' Meet in Pune via video message on 22nd June 2023. In his message, Hon. Prime Minister, inter-alia, emphasized the need to adapt and use new e-learning innovatively and said that the objective must be to provide quality education with better governance. He also stated that India would be happy to share experiences and resources available in SWAYAM and DIKSHA, particularly with those in the Global South.</p> <p>The Education Ministers' meeting was chaired by the Indian Chair, Hon. Union Minister for Education and Skill Development & Entrepreneurship. 150 G20 delegates comprising of Ministers from G20 nations, invitee countries and senior officials from International Organisations such as UNICEF, UNESCO & OECD were present at the Education Ministers' meeting.</p> <p>A series of bilateral meetings were also held during the 4th EdWG meeting to strengthen bilateral cooperation in education and skill development to greater heights. Hon. Union Education and Skill Development Minister met Vice Prime Minister and Minister of Tertiary Education, Science & Technology of Mauritius in Pune. He also held bilateral meetings with counterparts from UAE, UK, and Oman, and senior officials from UNICEF and OECD</p>
