



1	National Education Ministers' Conference	<p>National Education Ministers' Conference was held in Gujarat on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2022.</p> <p>Union Education Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan along with Shri Rajeev Chandrasekhar, MoS Skill Development &amp; Entrepreneurship and Electronics &amp; Information Technology; Smt. Annapurna Devi, MoS for Education; Dr. Subhash Sarkar, MoS for Education, Education Ministers of States/UTs and senior officials of Ministry of Education participated in the meeting.</p> <p>The conference deliberated on strengthening the education ecosystem in the country with focus on implementation of National Education Policy 2020, preparation of State Curriculum Framework (SCF), Sharing of strategies for Learning Recovery after School Reopening, Foundational Literacy and Numeracy and Vidya Pravesh, Skills in Schools, Student Registry and NDEAR etc.</p> <p>On the side-lines of the conference, Hon. Ministers and senior officers visited Vidya Samiksha Kendra (VSK), Bhaskaracharya National Institute for Space Applications and Geo-informatics (BISAG), National Forensic Science University (NFSU) and International Automobile Centre of Excellence (iACE).</p>

2	Support to Agnipath Scheme by Department of School Education & Literacy through National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS)	<p>The Ministry of Defence, GoI has unveiled the "Agnipath" scheme which is a pan India merit-based recruitment scheme for enrolling soldiers, airmen and sailors.</p> <p>To support this initiative, the Department of School Education &amp; Literacy through its autonomous institution, the National Institute of Open Schooling, in consultation with MoD has instituted a special programme to enable those Agniveers who are 10th class pass to further their education and obtain a 12th class pass Certificate by developing customized courses. This certificate is recognised for both employment and higher education purposes in the whole country. This will benefit the Agniveers to gain adequate educational qualification and skills to take up productive role in society later in life. NIOS will facilitate enrolment, development of courses, student support, provision of self-learning material, accreditation of study centres, personal contact programme, evaluation and certification.</p>
3	National Yoga Olympiad	<p>On 18th June 2022, Union Education and Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan inaugurated the National Yoga Olympiad - 2022 and quiz competition as Chief Guest. Minister of State for Education Shri Subhas Sarkar was also present on the occasion.</p> <p>The National Yoga Olympiad was organised jointly by the Ministry of Education and the National Council of Educational Research and Training from 18th to 20th June 2022. This year about 600 students from 26 states/ UTs and Demonstration Multipurpose Schools of Regional Institutions of Education participated in the National Yoga Olympiad.</p>
