**Subject: Minutes of the Supplementary PAB Meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 for the State of Uttar Pradesh for the year 2015-16 under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the Integrated Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA).**

The Meeting of Supplementary PAB under RMSA for the State of Uttar Pradesh for the year 2015-16, was held on 13<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 under the Chairmanship of Dr. S. C. Khuntia, Secretary (School Education & Literacy). A list of participants is at **Annexure-I**.

The Government of Uttar Pradesh has submitted the proposal vide letter dated 30.09.2015 for surrender of 225 new secondary schools (2 section), which were sanctioned in 2013-14 @Rs. 58.12 lakh per school (normative cost) based on 2009 PWD SSOR. The State has informed that no construction agency agreed to construct the school buildings on 2009 SSOR and construction of these 225 schools could not be started.

The State Government informed that these 225 schools have been made functional and they are unable to utilize the funds for their construction. Hence, they requested for cancellation of 225 schools approved in the year 2013-14 and approval of these 225 schools @Rs. 75.65 lakh based on current SSOR. The approval of PAB is required for cancellation and approval of these schools.

With a view to avoid blockage of funds and also make school buildings available to the schools, the PAB considered the proposal for cancellation of 225 schools (2 section) approved in the year 2013-14 @Rs.58.12 lakh/school with total outlay of Rs.13077.00 lakh and proposal for approval of these 225 new schools (2 section) @Rs.75.65 lakh/school with total outlay of Rs. 17021.25 lakh for the year 2015-16. PAB approved the following items:

PAB also allowed that the funds already released (Rs. 5204.67 lakh) for cancelled schools may be utilized for the schools approved in the year 2015-16.
