# 2. <u>It may be please be noted that this letter only accords administrative sanction for</u> participation under the new Scheme, to enable the Polytechnics to start preparations & obtain all administrative clearances for implementing the new Scheme. No financial expenditure should be incurred under the new CDTP Scheme, by the above Polytechnics, until this Ministry issues financial sanction and releases necessary funds. Towards this end, the above Polytechnics may please be advised to take prompt action to submit their acceptance to implement the Scheme (in format enclosed at Annex.I) & furnish information as described below to this Ministry.

3. The concerned State Governments and the Directors of Technical Education are requested to kindly facilitate the selected Polytechnics to rapidly operationalize the scheme during the current financial year and grant required approvals for operating bank accounts and completing other formalities expeditiously. In order to ensure the effective implementation of the Scheme, each Polytechnic may please be facilitated to have collaborations with local bodies, local industries, local Govt Departments and organizations at the local level, to ensure that the programmes offered under the Scheme are need based and facilitate employment opportunities.

4. The Scheme should be implemented by the above Institutes <u>strictly in accordance</u> with the provisions of the *Salient Features Document* and the Ministry's instructions and <u>Guidelines issued from time to time</u>. The overall responsibility for implementation of the Scheme will rest with the Principal of the Polytechnic, who must ensure compliance of all applicable norms, guidelines & instructions.

5. The <u>Salient Features Document</u> of the Scheme of Community Development Through Polytechnics may please be perused and downloaded from this Department's website – <u>http://www.education.nic.in/secondary.htm</u>, and clicking the following links therein (i) Technical Education; (ii) Schemes (iii) Sub-Mission on Polytechnics. To implement the aforementioned Scheme, the above Polytechnics are eligible for the following maximum grants in aid from time to time :-

- (a) **One time Non Recurring Grants-in-aid upto a maximum of Rs 20.00 lakhs** to new Polytechnics selected to implement the Scheme, for making the expenditure on non recurring items including equipment etc.
- (b) **Recurring Grants-in-aid upto a maximum of Rs 17.00 lakh per annum** for making recurring expenditure, including remuneration to the contractual Project Staff, stationary, consumables, technical material and other contingencies etc.

6. Immediately on receipt of this letter, The Principals of the above Institutes may take suitable action for preparation and approval of the Annual Operational Plan (AoP), in consultation with respective NITTTRs of their region at Bhopal Chandigarh, Kolkata & Chennai, as envisaged in the Scheme's *Salient Features Document* and should ensure that every expenditure incurred under the Scheme is incurred only for the activities/items as per

the approved AoP. The activities under the Scheme should be limited to the extent of grants-in-aid available with the grantee Institution at any given time. The grantee Institution would bear responsibility for any expenditure incurred over and above available grants and Ministry would not ordinarily be liable to reimburse the same, on a routine basis.

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7. The above Institutes <u>should immediately on receipt of this letter</u>, send to this <u>Ministry</u>, within 10 days, the details of their Institute as well as their Bank Account <u>particulars in the enclosed proforma (2 pages) at Annex I, duly signed by the Principal of the Polytechnic as well as concerned Bank Manager</u>.

Important Notes:- Polytechnics should not use words such as "Community or Scheme etc." while recording their name in Bank Account. Only the approved name of Polytechnic must be used or Electronic transfer of funds may be delayed/fail. <u>Polytechnics are advised that every</u> <u>Column of the enclosed proforma</u> (2 pages) must be compulsorily filled and nothing must be left blank, as sanction and release of funds is done electronically. The Bank details such as <u>MICR code & IFSC code may be filled in consultation with Bank, and should not be left blank</u>.

8. Submission to the Ministry, of the enclosed proforma (2 pages), by the Principals of the Polytechnics will be deemed as their acceptance to implement the Scheme and abide by the conditions governing the Scheme's implementation, as per the Instructions and Guidelines issued by this Ministry from time to time.

9. <u>All project staff under this Scheme should be engaged only after the financial sanction is issued by this Ministry and funds are actually released to the Polytechnics.</u> Such Project Staff should be engaged only as prescribed in the Scheme's Guidelines and the Principal of the Polytechnic must make clear to prospective contract employees at every stage of the recruitment, including in Public notices, Interview, contract etc. that the employment offered is purely temporary and under a project, approved for implementation on an annual basis.

10. Necessary financial sanction for the Grants-in-aid to be released during the year 2009-10, will be issued separately.
