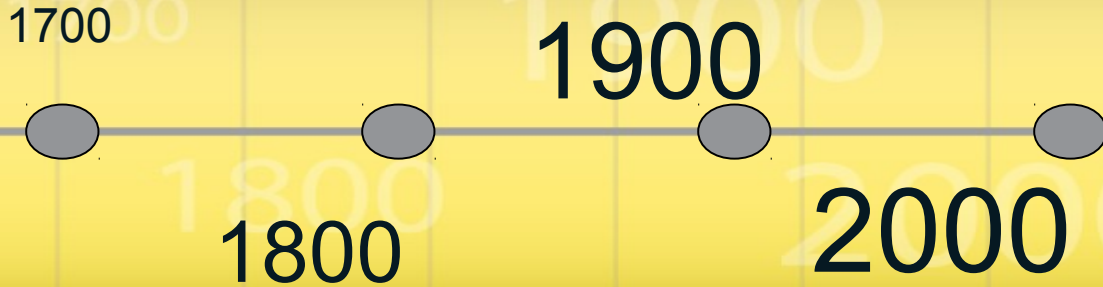

Evolution and Growth has been based on change



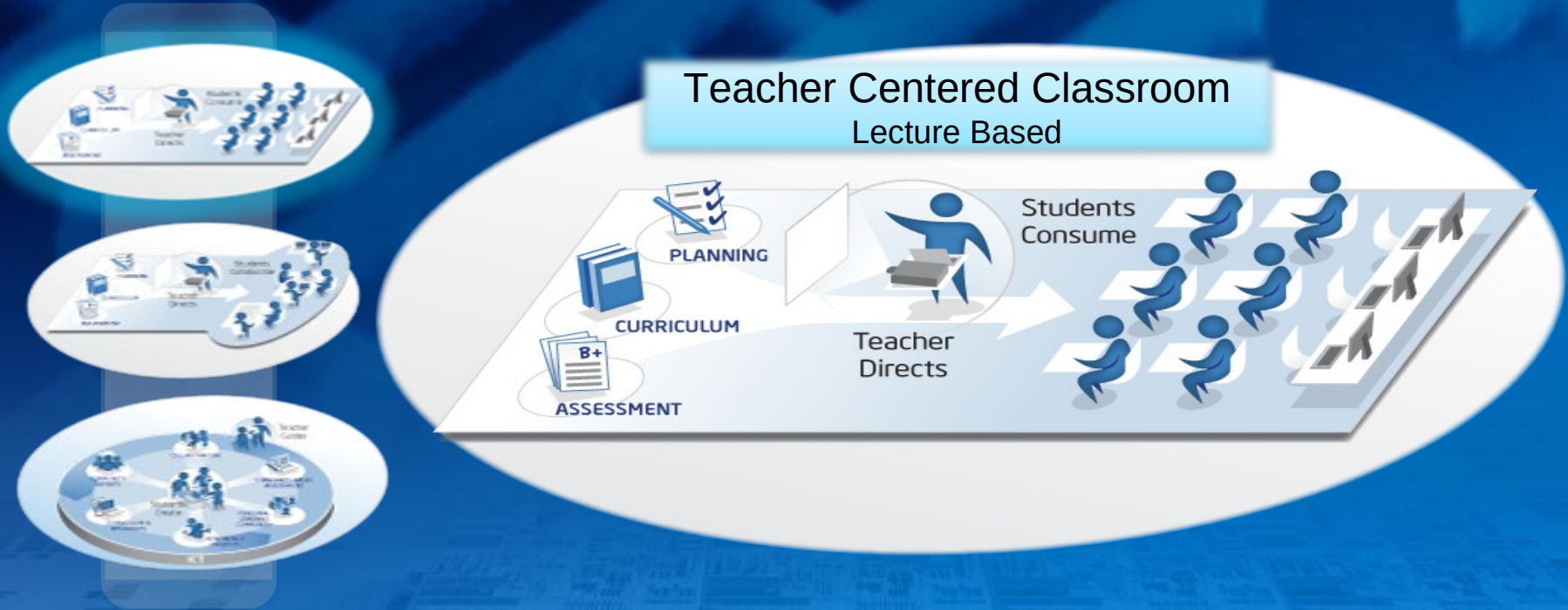

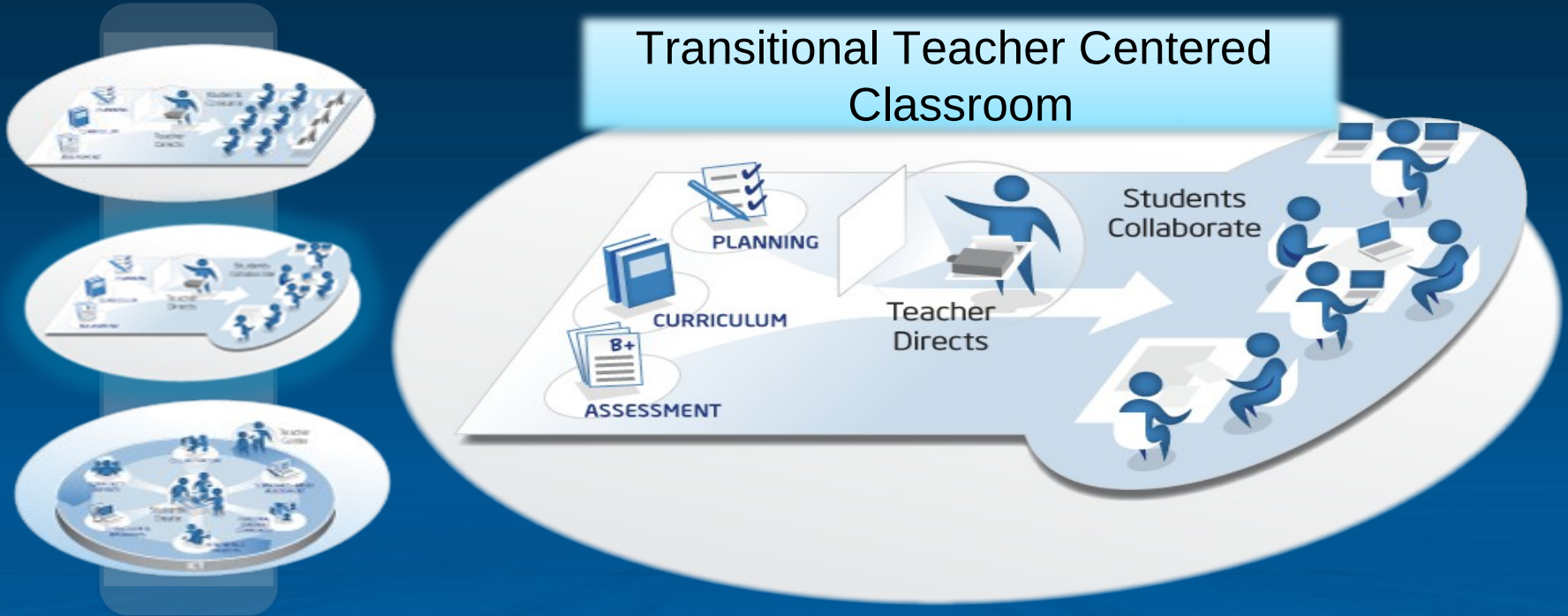


The shift in the Learning Paradigm

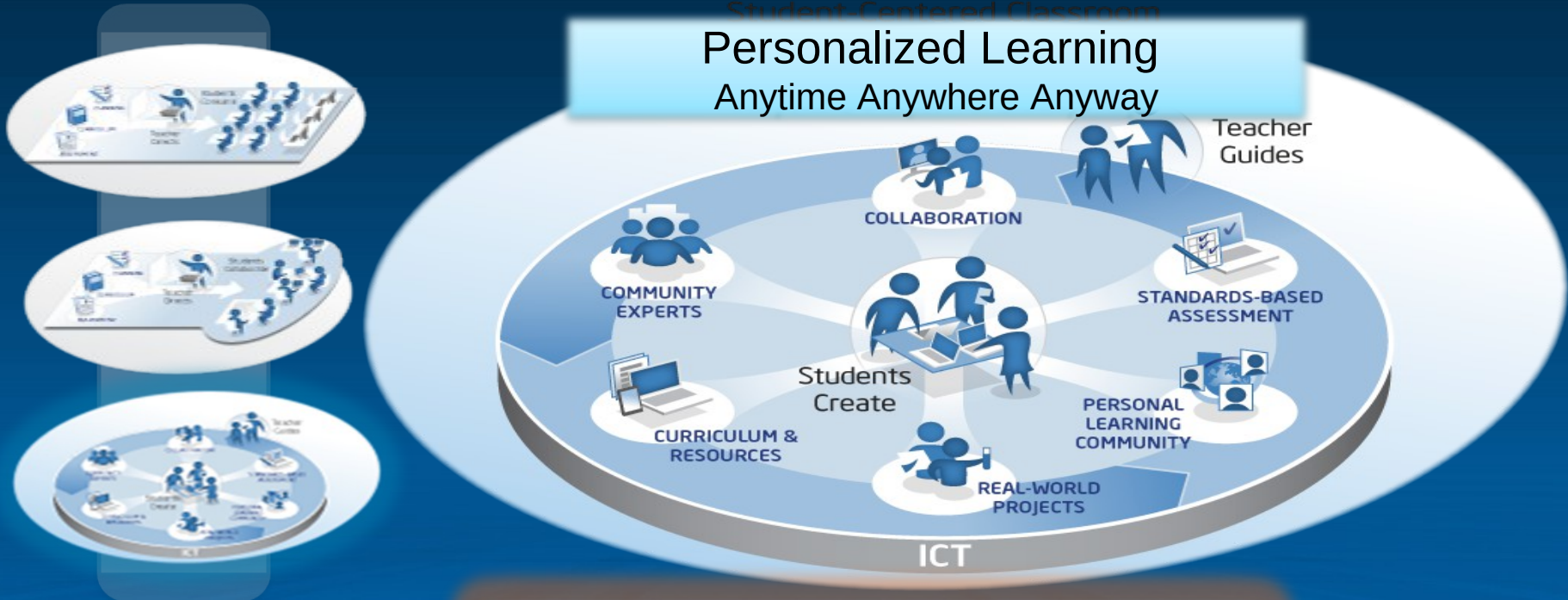

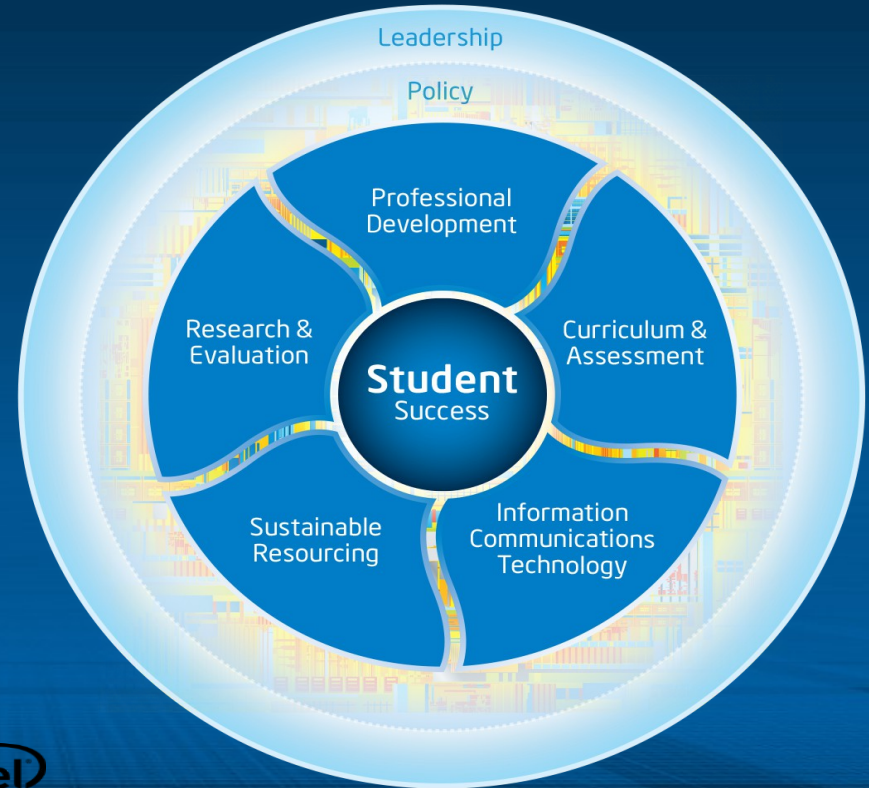
