

Recruitment of Teachers for New Schools and Additional Teachers for existing schools
Sanctioned under RMSA

Teachers for New Schools sanctioned in 2009-10, 2010-11 & 2011-12:

In the year 2009-10, 2010-11 & 2011-12, a total of 9691 schools were sanctioned. The total number of teachers sanctioned for their schools are 53745. In the year 2009-10 & 2010-11 teachers were sanctioned as per the norms of the state. In the year 2011-12 as per the decision taken by the National Mission, 6 subject teachers per school were approved.

Observation:-

Teachers Recruitment in New Schools in 2009-10:-

In the year 2009-10 as against the 2440 new schools sanctioned, 14769 teacher's posts were sanctioned. The total teacher posts recruited against the posts sanctioned are 7819.

52.94% posts have been filled up as against the posts sanctioned in 2009-10.

Though there is a substantial recruitment in 2009-10, the following states are yet to recruit teachers:

- **Bihar:** - In tune with the Elementary teacher's recruitment, where TET is required, secondary teachers are also to be recruited through separate TET. Advertisement has been published and around six lakh application has been received. Test is to be held in the month of 17th Feb, 2012.
- **Jammu & Kashmir:** - The state has only recruited Headmasters against the teachers sanctioned in 2009-10 & 2010-11. For the promotion of subject specific masters, no mode was fixed in the state. Now, the mode of promotion of subject specific masters has been devised recently. As such recruitment of subject specific masters is in pipeline.
- **Karnataka:** - The recruitment under process. But there has been no information on when the recruitment process would be completed.

Teachers Recruitment in New Schools in 2010-11:-

In the year 2010-11 as against the 3295 schools approved, 21093 posts of teachers were sanctioned. The total teachers recruited against the posts sanctioned are 6177.

29.28% posts have been filled up as against the posts sanctioned in 2010-11.

The following states are yet to recruit any teachers against post sanctioned in 2010-11.

- **Arunachal Pradesh:** - Recruitment of new-teacher sanctioned against 33 (11+22) Schools is under progress and teachers will be placed in school by end of Feb 2012.

- **Bihar:** - In tune with the Elementary teacher's recruitment, where TET is required, secondary teachers are also to be recruited through separate TET. Advertisement has already been published and around six lakh application has been received. Test is to be held in the month of 17th Feb, 2012.
- **Chandigarh:** - The UT not begun the recruitment process.
- **Gujarat:** - The Teacher recruitment in new school will be done by TAT (Teacher Aptitude Test) examination which is a centralized online process. It is under process.
- **Haryana:**-Recruitment would be through state teacher eligible test. This is awaited.
- **Himachal Pradesh:**-Teacher Recruitment has not been done as funds have not been released.
- **Kerala:**-Since the new schools have not opened, hence no teachers have been recruited yet.
- **Orissa:**-No reason has been provided on the reason for non-recruitment of teachers.
- **Uttar Pradesh:**-No reason has been provided in the reason for non-recruitment of teachers.

Teachers Recruitment in New Schools in 2011-12:-

In the year 2011-12, as against the 3956 schools approved, 17883 teachers were sanctioned. 20.44% posts have been filled up as against the posts sanctioned in 2011-12.

Some special reference:-

- 1) In the case of Jharkhand, Nagaland, Meghalaya and Puducherry no information has been provided by the state on the recruitment of teachers in new schools.
- 2) In the case of Gujarat, the total numbers of schools have been reduced from 328 to 256. The total number of teachers would require to be reduced from 1968 to 1536.
- 3) The teachers in new schools are sanctioned for the subjects of 2 language, science, maths & social science. In Tamil Nadu, posts of Physical Education teachers have been sanctioned in view of the posts approved under RMSA.

Teachers for Existing Schools:

There are 23605 existing schools for which additional teachers were proposed in the year 2011-12. The total number of teachers sanctioned under RMSA for existing schools is 52352. Andhra Pradesh has recruited 9569 teachers as against the total 19011 teachers sanctioned. Karnataka, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu are yet to recruit any teachers against the teachers sanctioned.
