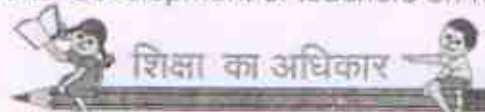
As you are aware, the National Repository of Open Educational Resources (NROER) had been launched in August, 2013 as an initiative of the Department of School Educational and Literacy, MHRD and the Central Institute of Educational Technology (CIET), National Council of Educational Research and Technology (NCERT).

2. Central Institute of Educational Technology (CIET) is working towards establishing a mechanism for partnerships or alliances through specific and separate agreements with different Governmental and Non-Governmental agencies, educational institutions or individuals from different states / UTs to participate and contribute resources to the NROER.

3. It is proposed to create a core group on NROER in each State / UT with a number of trained resource persons for creation, collation, curation and contribution of resources in the repository. This core group of 10 members will then act as Resource master trainers in their respective States / UTs to lead and carry forward the activities on NROER through events and training programmes to encourage educational institutions, teachers and other e-content creators, to share their content, engage in peer review, and adapt as well as adopt resources to enrich this repository and thereby making the teaching-learning process more effective as well as efficient in their respective states / UTs. The core group will undertake to curate their existing syllabi at the school and teacher education level, translate all the identified concepts and the corresponding relations and tags into their own regional / state language(s) along with uploading the same on NROER with their respective metadata.

4. You are requested to identify and constitute a core group on NROER (involving 10 faculty members of your state from amongst the teachers, teacher educators, subject experts, trainers etc. from schools, Boards, SCERT / SIE, RMSA, SSA, DIETs, CTEs / IASEs, SIET and universities etc. who have expertise and been involved with various activities in the school system including the development of e-content and professional development of teachers on ICT in education) and encourage


them to participate in capacity building / orientation programmes at CIET, NCERT, New Delhi. Kindly ensure that the team members have very good bi/ multi-lingual communication skills and are able to translate existing e-contents in English / Hindi into the State / regional language(s).

5. For facilitating the process of making this e-content available in your State language(s), simultaneous typing of the content will be one of the pre requisite.

6. You are requested to depute one faculty / staff member proficient in typing using Unicode in your state language along with the team. I also request you to share details of this team (including a brief resume and contact numbers / mail IDs) so as to help us to identify the best place for them in the team.
