The expenditure involved is debitable to Demand No.51- Department of School Education and Literacy – Major Head ‘3601 Grants-in-Aid to State Government 02-Grants for State Plan Scheme, 165-Elementary Education-Other Grants, 02-Development of Minorities; Education Scheme for Madarsas/ Minorities, 01-Scheme for Providing education to Madarsas/Minorities; 02.01.31-Grant-in-aid General (Plan) 2016-17.

5. The amount of the grant is to be utilized only for the purpose for which it was sanctioned. Accounts from the State Government to be furnished to the Central Government within one year of issue of the sanction positively along with the monitoring report regarding number of Madrasas receiving assistance, total number of beneficiary students and the amounts received and utilized by the Madrasas.

7. It may also be ensured that utilization certificate in respect of this grant may be furnished as a separate and distinct set of proposal as forwarded to this Department under Scheme for Providing Quality Education in Madarsas (SPQEM).
