Subject : State Plan Scheme-Implementation of the Scheme for Providing Quality Education in Madarasas (SPQEM) in Uttarakhand during 2015-16- release of 1st instalment during 2015-16 regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to say that Government of India has approved an expenditure of Rs. 7,70,27,000/- (Rs. Seven Crore Seventy Lakh and Twenty Seven Thousand only) to State Government of Uttarakhand under the Scheme for Providing Quality Education in Madarasas (SPQEM) for the year 2015-16 for 194 Madarasas(renewal) in CGIAC meeting held on 14.1.2016. The Grant-in-Aid is for giving assistance to 194 **Madrasas (renewal)** as indicated below:-

2. Accordingly, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to release a sum of Rs. 3,85,13,500/- (Rs. Three Crore Eighty Five Lakh Thirteen Thousand and Five Hundred only) as 1st installment to Secretary, Deptt. of Minority Welfare & Wakf Section-3, Government of Uttarakhand for implementation of the above mentioned scheme for the year 2015-16 subject to fulfilling of all terms and conditions laid down in the scheme and in terms of this Ministry's letter dated 29.10.2008. This is also subject to the condition that the Madrasas seeking financial assistance fulfill eligibility conditions as per para 9-13 of the Scheme and all the teachers are actually engaged during 2015-16 and possess requisite qualification. This is a purely voluntary scheme and the concerned institution has to apply to the State Government.
3. The expenditure involved is debitable to Demand No.59-Department of School Education and Literacy – Major Head '3601 Grants-in-Aid to State Government 02-Grants for State Plan Scheme, 165-Elementary Education, the Scheme for Providing education to Madrasas/Minorities 01.00.31-Grant-in-aid General (Plan) 2015-16.
4. It is certified that the grant in aid is being released in accordance with the pattern of assistance approved by the Planning Commission and the Ministry as also in conformity with the rules and regulations of the scheme.
5. The amount of the grant is to be utilized only for the purpose for which it was sanctioned. Accounts from the State Government to be furnished to the Central Government within one year issue of the sanction positively along with the monitoring report regarding number of Madrasas receiving assistance, total number of beneficiary students and the amounts received and utilized by the Madrasas.
6. On receipt of the sanction letter, the Principal Accounts Officer may issue an advice to Reserve Bank of India (Central Accounts Section), Nagpur for affording credit to the balance of the State Government. The Principal Accounts Officer may forward a copy of the advice to the Accountant General and finance Department of State Government concerned along with a copy to the undersigned.
7. It may also be ensured that utilization certificate in respect of this grant may be furnished as a separate and distinct set of proposal as forwarded to this Department under Scheme for Providing Quality Education in Madarasas (SPQEM).
8. No previous UC is pending in respect of these Madarasas.
9. The accounts of grantee shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act, 1971 and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so.

10. This issues in exercise of the delegated powers in consultation with the Integrated Finance Division's vide their Dy. No. 503-IFD/2016 dated 12.02.2016 and Finance Branch vide their Dy. No791/16-IF-II dated 19.02.2016.
